

Lincoln Park North Competition

PRESENTATION DRAWINGS AND SCALE: CORRECTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

The Graham Foundation has made a number of errors in the competition submission requirements and layout format, which are described on page seven of the competition brief. We apologize.

1. BASE MAP

The large site plan (the “base map”) provided by the Foundation on the competition Web site is NOT at a scale of 1:150, as indicated in submission requirement #1 and in the layout format (area A). The true scale of the drawing is approximately 1”=250’ (1:3000).

The Foundation prefers that entrants use the previously provided 60” x 12” “base map” within the 60” x 12” space shown on the layout. That is, we prefer that you use a scale of 1” = 250’. You may slide the map east-west to expose more or less of the lake as required by your scheme.

However, the Foundation will NOT EXCLUDE drawings that are either at a scale of 1” = 150’ or at a scale of 1:150, although in both cases the full site cannot be shown and the ability of the Jury to understand the scheme may be diminished.

2. DETAIL SITE PLAN

The scale for the Detail Plan (submission requirement #2 and area B of the layout) should read 1” = 50’ NOT 1:50. At a scale of 1” to 50’, a 600’ x 600’ area can be explored in depth within the 12” x 12” space provided in the layout. It is unlikely that this size area will be able to include the multiple blocks requested by the Foundation, and thus this requirement is waived.

HOWEVER, the Foundation will NOT EXCLUDE site plans in layout area B that adhere to the “two blocks wide by one block deep minimum” requirement at a different scale, nor will we exclude schemes drawn at a scale of 1:50 (i.e. 1” = 4’2”). In the latter instance, however, since the area covered within the 12” x 12” layout space would be only 50’ x 50’, we urge that a larger detail site plan be included in one of the free presentation spaces.

The Graham Foundation again apologizes for the inconvenience that these errors may have caused. No submission crafted in reliance on our original request will be disqualified.
